KCC Household Support Fund

Funded by the Department for Work and Pensions on behalf of the UK government, the Household Support Fund scheme supports vulnerable Kent households in need of help with significantly rising living costs.

Each household can apply for one of the following:

- £100 energy support
- £100 food voucher
- £60 food voucher and £40 energy support.

If your application is approved, your food voucher or energy support will be sent to you by email.

It's currently open to applications and you can apply if you:

- are aged 16 or over
- are a Kent resident, permanently living within one of the 12 local authorities covered by Kent County Council (this excludes Medway, Bexley, or Bromley)
- have a household income of less than £40,000 per year, including benefits and employment income
- have less than £1,000 in savings
- do not get free school meals vouchers from your child's school over the school holidays, for any child within your household.

We hope this may be of use to some of our families.
