Reading

In our reading lessons we will studying a range of texts:

The Boy in the Tower by Polly Ho-Yen

The poem 'Our Tower' by Joseph Coelho and Richard Johnson.

The focus is on developing an understanding of vocabulary, inferring information from the text and using evidence to support answers.

Writing

Our writing this term will be based on The Boy in the Tower by Polly Ho-Yen.

The children will be building up their suspense writing toolkit to write an exciting narrative. The children will practise the different elements in isolation before bringing all of their writing skills together.

The children will also be writing an explanation text.

Educational Visit

This term the children will be swimming at Hartsdown Leisure Centre. The children also have the opportunity to visit Creed - an outdoor adventure centre.

PSHE

The theme of our PSHE lessons this term is Growing and Changing. The children will also spend time meeting secondary school staff and preparing for their transition to secondary education.

Maths

The children will be completing mathematical challenges based on the whole Key Stage 2 curriculum. The children will solve real life problems involving money, holidays and travelling.

The children will continue practising their number skills so that they are prepared for the start of Year 7.

Science

The children will be continuing to learn about light.

This will include learning about:

- 1. How do our eyes work?
- 2. How does a periscope work?

We will also spend a few lessons recapping previously taught topics.



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History

Our key theme of the term is looking at 'How does the Mayan civilisation compare with our own, both at the time and now?'. Our key questions for this term are:
